



# 2020 Stuff the Bus Report on Activities

## About Stuff the Bus

Each year, United Way of Frederick County works with local partners to collect donations of school supplies to **provide students with the supplies they need to start the school year.**

While last year was different and challenging, the generosity of the Frederick County community sent a message to students that said, "we have not forgotten you and we care". This reflected in the number of students who received the necessary supplies to start the school year; 6,922 students, an increase of 44% over the 4,000 students served in 2019, and the most students we have ever served in a single year!

Community partners including Frederick County Public Schools, Religious Coalition for Emergency Human Needs serving the Frederick Feeder schools, Frederick Stake – Church of Latter-day Saints, Evangelical Reformed United Church of Christ, Middletown Valley People Helping People, Glade Family Community Services serving Walkersville, and BEACON (Brunswick Ecumenical Assistance Committee on Needs) help make Stuff the Bus a huge success.

Our commitment to providing school supplies to students in Frederick County continues. Kids in our community need the tools and support to learn - now more than ever.
